

**TOWN OF MONTVILLE
NOTICE OF ADJOURNED
TOWN MEETING AND
REFERENDUM**

Pursuant to Town of Montville Charter § C803 and Connecticut General Statutes § 7-7, notice is hereby given to the electors and qualified voters (eligible taxpayers) of the Town of Montville that a Town referendum will be held on Tuesday, March 8, 2016 between the hours of 6:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M. (E.D.T.) for the purpose of voting on the question:

WHETHER ORDINANCE NO. 2016-01, ENTITLED “ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE TOWN OF MONTVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT,” SHALL BE OVERRULED.

The ballot label for said question shall read as follows:

Shall Ordinance No. 2016-01, entitled “Ordinance Establishing the Town of Montville Police Department,” be overruled, meaning that an independent Town of Montville Police Department will not be established?

A "YES" vote will overrule the Ordinance, meaning that the Town of Montville will not have its own independent Montville Police Department;

A "NO" vote will allow Ordinance No. 2016-001 to go into effect on the date of the referendum, resulting in the establishment of an independent Town of Montville Police Department as a department of the Town.

Optical scan machines will be used.

The polls will be open during the hours between 6:00A.M. and 8:00P.M. (E.D.T.) and electors shall cast their votes at the following places in the districts specified:

Districts 1-6 Fair Oaks School, 836 Old Colchester Rd., Oakdale

Qualified voters will vote at Fair Oaks School.

Copies of the aforesaid question are on file, open to public inspection, in the office of the Town Clerk. Absentee ballots will be made available in accordance with law. Town Hall has been designated the central location for counting absentee ballots.

The vote on the aforesaid resolution is to be taken under the authority of § 803 of the Town Charter and Chapter 90 of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended.
