- **C)** Water Quality Sampling: Russ noted that the Ecosystems proposal for the 2016 Monitoring Program is \$5,420. Kate will provide copies for next month's meeting.

- When there is a problem occurring on the lake, there should be a phone tree so that more people can be made aware of the problem and report what they are seeing to DEEP. The concept is that the more calls into DEEP, the better able they will be to respond to the violation.
