 216IWC7 – 140 Derry Hill Road (Map 33, Lot 39), Uncasville, CT – Applicant: David Fowler, Public Works Dir., Property Owner: MTIC Acquisitions, LLC – Driveway Crossing Improvements (Decision Required Date 08-19-2016).
 It was clarified that Mr. David Fowler is the Public Works Director for MTIC

(Mohegan Tribe of Indians of Connecticut) Acquisitions, LLC. The Commission reviewed a map of the actual driveway crossing, a map of the entire property, including the wetlands, and photographs of the piping. Representing MTIC Public Works Director Fowler, Operations and Senior Project Manager Chris Clark, stated that there are no records of the original installation of the culvert on record, but estimates the piping to be at least 20 (twenty) years of age. They would like to remove the existing

squash pipe, which has been in a state of disrepair for several years, and install a RCP (Reinforced Concrete Pipe) and armor the outlet section. Per the recommendation of the Town Engineer, they are currently in the process of evaluating the inlet protection. Currently, there is no rip-rap at the inlet or outlet. WEO Burdick stated that the item has been referred to the Town Engineer, who reviewed the drainage calculations and determined that they are appropriate for the design, and the Soil Scientist, who had five (5) comments that are being addressed by the Applicant.

Motion made by Commissioner Houk, seconded by Commissioner O'Bday, to schedule a site walk for Saturday, July 16, 2016, 10:00 a.m. Voice vote, 5-0, all in favor. Motion carried.
