NOTICE OF ORDINANCE HEARING

The following Ordinance, copies of which may be obtained at the office of the Town Clerk during office hours, was introduced at a regular meeting of the Town Council held November 10, 2014, and a public hearing thereon and for its consideration by the Town Council will be held at Town Hall Council Chambers, December 8, 2014 at 6:00 P.M.

ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE REGISTRAR OF VOTERS

THE TOWN OF MONTVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Sec 1 –Number of

At each election at which the electors choose Registrars of Voters, there shall be elected two such Registrars one for each major political party. The election of the Registrars shall follow the provisions of Section 9-190 of the Connecticut General Statutes. Each Registrar so elected shall be a resident of the Town of Montville and upon ceasing to be a resident shall cease to hold office.

Sec 2 –Term of Office

Each Registrar of Voters elected pursuant to this chapter shall serve a term of two years. The term shall commence from the Wednesday following the first Monday of January succeeding an election for Registrar of Voters.

Sec 3 –Power and Duties

They shall have all the powers and duties conferred or imposed by law on Registrar of Voters.

Sec 4 –Salaries and Benefits

The Registrar of Voters shall be paid salaries in lieu of all fees, such salaries to be fixed by the Town Council.

Resolutions 91-271 and 2004-148 regarding medical insurance and cost shares are repealed.

Registrars of Voters elected or appointed (in the event a current Registrar of Voters leaves office during their term) after the November 2014 election shall be ineligible to receive health insurance benefits through the Town. The Registrars of Voters presently in office as of November 1, 2014, shall receive health insurance benefits until they no longer hold office or **January 9, 2017, whichever comes first.**

Registrars of Voters elected or appointed (in the event a current Registrar of Voters leaves office during their term) after the November 2014 election shall work less than twenty hours per week and will not qualify as “members” of the Connecticut Municipal Employees Retirement System (“CMERS”) pursuant to Chapter 113 of the Connecticut General Statutes. The Registrars of Voters presently in office as of November 1, 2014, shall continue to work twenty or more hours per week and shall remain eligible for participation in CMERS until they no longer hold office.

Commencing January 9, 2017 and thereafter Registrars of Voters will no longer be eligible to participate in health insurance benefits or CMERS through the Town.

This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days from the date of its adoption.
