<u>DFC (Drug Free Communities)</u> – Montville is target town (125k/yr for 5 years), SERAC received it and their aim is to administer a survey for Montville students for grades 8 – 12 and pay for mental health/first aid training for town departments and schools <u>DCF</u> – via probation services for case management and youth that benefit from JRB, CYSA received the grant - 1 year/\$10k for case management and pro-socials for JRB kids for example: summer camp <u>CSSD</u> – LIST Grant - \$17k/1 year - \$12k to offset staff salary, \$5k to families for direct

- <u>TOW Foundation</u> National League of Cities \$30,000 purpose is to engage municipal leaders in diverting children from the system
