  - **a.**) **Carol S. Rasmussen/CDM Homes:** An application for a Zoning Permit for the construction of a single family dwelling on the property located at Route 32 (a.k.a. 28 Thomas Avenue), Uncasville, CT. As shown on Assessor's Map 91 Lot 28. (see below item 8.1.b)
  - b.) Carol S. Rasmussen/CDM Homes: An application for a Zoning Permit for the construction of a single family dwelling on the property located at Route 32 (a.k.a. 38 Thomas Avenue), Uncasville, CT. As shown on Assessor's Map 91 Lot 38. Chairman Marcus informed the Commission that although both items would be heard together, they would be voted on separately. Staff advised that there had been correspondence back and forth between the Town Engineer and the Applicant's Engineer over this matter. Staff entered Tom Fenton's letter (Summary of Engineering Review) into the record. Tom Fenton, Town Engineer discussed his summary with the Commission. Discussion was held. Commission concerns included, but were not limited to; drainage, grading, and the applicant not hooking up to public sewers. A MOTION was made by COMMISSIONER PIENIADZ; SECONDED by COMMISSIONER POLHEMUS to DENY Item 6.1.a. An application for a Zoning Permit for the construction of a single family dwelling on the property located at Route 32 (a.k.a. 28 Thomas Avenue), Uncasville, CT. As shown on Assessor's Map 91 Lot 28. The reason for denial is that the plans, as submitted, show that surface water from and/or on to abutting properties will be altered as explained in the Town Engineer's report. Roll call vote as follows: In

An application for a Zoning Permit for the construction of a single family dwelling on the property located at Route 32 (a.k.a. 38 Thomas Avenue), Uncasville, CT. As shown on Assessor's Map 91 Lot 38. The reason for denial is that the plans, as submitted, show that surface water from and/or on to abutting properties will be altered as explained in the Town Engineer's report. Roll call vote as follows: In favor: Commissioners Baron, Desjardins, Ferrante, Marcus, Polhemus, Pieniadz, Siragusa and Toner. Opposed: none. 8-0-0 MOTION CARRIED.

A MOTION was made by COMMISSIONER DESJARDINS; SECONDED by COMMISSIONER SIRAGUSA to ADD item 6.1.c. Cease & Desist Order (to the agenda). Voice vote 8-0-0 MOTION CARRIED.

c.) Staff informed the Commission of an issue with the property located at 1510 Route 163. He advised them that an Initial Inquiry was sent in September and is asking the Commission authorize him to forward the matter to the Town Attorney for the issuance of a Cease & Desist Order. The problems stem from industrial equipment being stored on a lot located in a WRP Zone. A MOTION was made as follows by COMMISSIONER BARON; SECONDED by COMMISSIONER SIRAGUSA to authorize the Zoning Enforcement Officer to ask the Town Attorney to send a Cease & Desist Order to property located at 1510 Route 163 due to storage of industrial equipment in a residential zone. Discussion was held. Voice vote. 8-0-0 All in favor. MOTION CARRIED.
