Mayor Ronald McDaniel announced today the Town's efforts to distribute 2,340 ANTIGEN SELF TESTS for COVID-19 Infection Detection. This distribution results from a cooperative effort with Governor Ned Lamont, the State Department of Public Health, State Department of Emergency Management and Homeland Security, the Connecticut National Guard, the Uncas Health District, and the Town of Montville.

This distribution is a proactive effort to slow the spread of the coronavirus especially during the holiday season as people travel to see relatives amid a surge of cases due to the omicron variant.

Emergency Management personnel are expected to obtain the COVID-19 Self-Tests on Thursday morning, December 30, 2021. Personnel will pass out the Self-Tests to residents of Montville from 10:30 AM to 4:30 PM or while supplies last at Leonard J. Tyl Middle School parking-lot at 166 Chesterfield Road. Residents will need to bring proof of their residency, such as government issued identification or a piece of mail addressed to the resident at their home. Each resident will be given (2) self-test kits.
