Subject: Site Modification

303, 307, & 309 Norwich New London Turnpike / Route 32

The Department of Transportation (Department) has reviewed your latest plans for the above-noted subject received December 5, 2022, entitled, "Site Modification" dated August 12, 2022. Your submittal/application to work within the State right of way or perform work that may affect State property is denied based on the following comments:

- 1. Proof of Town approval must be submitted prior to the issuance of an encroachment permit.
- 2. Provide STOP sign, stop bar, and 25' of DYCL.
- 3. Provide a detail for the breakaway sign support system in the plan set. If you would like a PDF version of the Breakaway Sign Support detail sent to you electronically, please email Mr. Gary Brigham at gary.brigham@ct.gov.
- 4. Call out the radius of the proposed drive on the plan set.
- 5. Plantings are not allowed in the State's right of way. Revise plans to show all proposed plantings are on private property.

When you resubmit, please provide two sets of plans, 40 scale or larger, reflecting the above-noted comments. Please note that any resubmission may generate additional comments and concerns and in no way guarantees the issuance of an encroachment permit. An encroachment permit must be obtained prior to performing any work within or affecting the highway right of way.
