THE TOWN OF MONTVILLE WATER AND SEWER COMMISSION HEREBY RESOVES to redirect FY \$25,000 from the 2023 WS CIP Funding (Valve/VFD Maple Avenue PS) for construction/installation of a manhole to allow a flow meter (to be placed at the intersection of Depot Road and Route 32) for evaluation of the current unaccounted water problem as well as future flow observations. The meter could effectively reduce the investigation area by 20%. It is requested that a pre-vetted contractor be employed with waiver of bid as per the Town Purchasing Policy.
