## Coggeshall timber Harvest

This is a timber harvest plan for the property of 867 Raymond hill road oakdale ct. The goal of this harvest is to cut the low quality, unhealthy, and fully mature trees to promote growth to the residual stand and allow sunlight to reach the forest floor to promote new growth. Trees will be cut and pulled out with a log skidder down an existing skid road to the landing. Tops will be slashed down to 2 feet or less.
