Police Department Report

Lt. Radford reported the Police Department statistics for month ending August 31, 2023. Reported were 945 calls for service. A total of 113 citations were issued that included 39 infractions, 13 misdemeanors, and 61 written warnings. He also reported that Officer Witts

and K9 Officer Sig have started their formal training and are doing very well. Officers Hughes and Mora Serna are in their third phase of FTO and doing well. Officer Victor DeSimone will be sworn on October 2, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. in the Town Council Chambers. This is a lateral staff placement. Lt. Radford presented Chairman Murphy, who was absent from last month's meeting, with a commemorative patch in honor of Independence Day that was presented to each Commissioner.

Fire Marshal Report

Fire Marshal Barnes reported Fire Marshal Statistics for the month ending August 31, 2023, as follows: Inspections of businesses and apartments (27), Fire investigations (4), Incident responses/requested to the scene (5), Burn permits issued (4), Plan Reviews (1) and Complaints (1). During the month of August, a total of six (6) hours was spent on Emergency Management obligations. The Fire Marshal also reported that career Firefighter Don Ellis was recently recognized by the IAFF Burn Survivor Summit in Washington, DC this past week and voted Councilor of the Year by his peers. For the past 14 years, Firefighter Ellis has used most of his allotted vacation time at the Arthur C. Luf Burn Camp in Milford, CT as a volunteer camp counselor. As a dedicated, career firefighter for the past 20-plus years for the Town of Montville, this recognition is a once in a lifetime and well-deserved acknowledgement of Firefighter Ellis' accomplishments.
