V. YAC (Youth Action Council) (Brendan Duhamel Report)

- Surveying Tyl and MHS students about social media, bullying, substance use, stress and mental health. Hoping to have both schools participate in the survey (questions were created by YAC members) prior to Christmas vacation. YAC will use the results to continue the "What's in your head, should be said" campaign, the Opioid Education project and their Community Kindness campaign
- SOR Grant for \$10,000 Addiction Memory Quilt, speakers, Narcan for schools, social media posts and peer to peer Lunch and Learns.
- Relaunching the 2020 Kind>Cool Campaign, starting with a "shout out" program where students can digitally nominate someone in their school or community to be recognized for going above and beyond for someone
- Will be meeting over Christmas break to start looking at survey results and create an action plan for rolling out the results in January of 2024
- Planted 100 daffodils near new community playground
