High School Social Studies teacher Elizabeth Gawlak presented the rationale for offering the new course AP African American Studies at Montville High School. In her overview, she shared that this course directly aligns with the Connecticut Social Studies standards and with College, Career and Civic Life Framework for Social Studies. The inquiry-based approach to learning in this course will enhance the work the high school has done around the Vision of Graduate work. Additionally, this course will provide the chance for more students who are interested in this content to enroll. There are no estimated costs associated with offering this additional cost and it will be taught by existing Social Studies teachers.
