The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation

The purpose of this project is to address the operational, safety and preventative maintenance concerns as well as to evaluate, and if necessary, improve the structural integrity of the bridge to a “state of good repair” extending its useful service life.

Right-of-way impacts are not anticipated.

Construction is expected to start in spring 2028, depending on funding, right-of-way acquisition, and permits. The estimated cost is \$32.8 million, with 80 percent Federal funds and 20 percent State funds.
