On Going Program Dates

These programs run year round. Each session is eight weeks. Check our website for specifics of each program.

Karate classes: Classes are held at JKA Montville's location at 1242 Old Colchester Road. Classes for ages 4 through adult. Sessions: \$80 Montville residents and \$95 for non-residents for once per week and \$120 residents and \$125 non-residents for twice per week.

Yoga class: Class is for adults 18 and older. Thursday nights from 6-7 pm in the Town Hall Gym. Heather Provost leads the class each week. All abilities are welcome. Eight weeks of classes. \$60 Montville residents and \$65 for non-residents.
