On Going Program Dates

These programs run year round. Each session is eight weeks.

Check our website for specifics of each program.

Karate classes: Classes are held at JKA Montville's location at 1242 Old Colchester Road. Classes for ages 4 through adult. Sessions: \$80 Montville residents and \$85 for non-residents for once per week and \$120 residents and \$125 non-residents for twice per week.

Gymnastic classes: Classes for children ages 18 months through high school on Tuesdays at Montville Town Hall. Varying levels of age and skill available. \$130 Montville residents and \$135 for non-residents.

Dance classes: Classes for children 3 years old through adult. Tap, Ballet, Jazz/Hip Hop, Tap/Ballet combo, Lyrical, Adult Tap, Ballet Barre. Check our website for specific days/times and class style. \$54 Montville residents and \$59 for non-residents.

Yoga class: Class is for adults 18 and older. Thursday nights from 6-7 pm in the Town Hall Gym. Heather Provost leads the class each week. All abilities are welcome. Eight weeks of classes. \$60 Montville residents and \$65 for non-residents.
