## SUMMER CAMP NEWS

This year's summer camp dates are June 24 to August 9. Each day camp begins at 8 am and concludes at 4 pm. There will be no camp on July 4th or 5th. Camp will be located at Montville High School utilizing the gym, cafeteria, auditorium and outdoor spaces. There will be optional trips for the campers to attend at an additional cost. Breakfast and lunch are included in the weekly price of \$75 per week.

Children must be 5 years old at the time they begin camp and not older than 12 years. We have a limit of 230 campers per week. Some weeks fill up so register early. Camp registration begins Tuesday, May 14th at 8 am both in person and online.

Groups are broken down into boys and girls and then age groups of 5-6, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12. Each group will have their own counselors who plan the activities each week.

Bus transportation is provided from and to Mohegan, Murphy, Oakdale and Palmer Schools for those campers needing it. The schedule will be available at registration.



### **SUMMER CAMP COUNSELOR JOB APPLICATIONS OPEN**

Want a challenging and rewarding job this summer? Then this is the place for you. Camp counselors are scheduled to work 40 hours per week for seven weeks. Plus approximately 33 hours of training time is held prior to start of camp. Counselors are responsible for planning and implementing activities for their group of campers, going on day trips with them and teaching them social skills.

Pay begins at \$15.69 per hour. Approximate employment dates are between June 17th and August 9th.
