#### **Public Comments**

Approximately 30 people attended the GLA meeting, including State Representative Ed Jutila, Senator Andrea Stillman, DEP Director of Boating, Education & Safety, Eleanor C. Mariani and Vice President of GZA GeoEnvironmental, Inc., Stanley Dynia.

Russ Smith opened the meeting by passing out a list of concerns that were discussed at a previous GLA meeting in hopes of finding solutions to ongoing problems occurring on Gardner Lake (see attached).

Russ Smith also discussed the urgency of applying for a four million dollar grant for projects that improve and support ecosystem management and habitat restoration in Connecticut. The deadline for this application must be submitted by July 29, 2010.

Many people spoke about the new state boat launch and public beach area stating their concerns about the increase in boat traffic. The GLA budget does not have enough money to cover the patrolling that should take place on the lake, given the high volume of boat traffic. Eleanor Mariani with DEP recommended that people call in violators when they witness unsafe or illegal behavior. The DEP number to call is 860-424-3333. The following information is needed when making this call: The type of violation, location, direction the boat was heading, description of boater (clothing), registration number and time. It was mentioned that DEP should assist in patrolling the lake and monitoring boats being put into the lake from the public boat launch area. There should be a life guard present at the public beach as well. Some people suggested putting in a toll booth to collect money to help off-set the cost of patrol and life guard.

David Rolly from the Montville police department said that their boat and officers are stretched thin and it is difficult to provide the amount of coverage that Gardner Lake needs. Having the assistance from DEP patrol would certainly help. He also said people could call into the Montville Troup E Barracks to report violations at 860-848-6500.

The only boating speed limit is 6 mph before sunrise and after sunset. It was mentioned that setting up speed limits during the day would be helpful as well.

Gary Payton stated that jet skis and boats are speeding too close to his roped in swim area. The jet skiers are completely out of control ignoring safety rules.

#### **Meeting Minutes**
