

Instructions if you have transferred out of Connecticut or have been discharged for Non-Resident Military

Please complete the Non-Resident Affidavit for Property Tax Exemptions (also known as Soldiers' & Sailors' Affidavit.) Since you have transferred out of Connecticut, the affidavit needs to be completed for the period of time that you were stationed in *Montville*. Fill it out as though you are back in that time period, including #2 present duty station as Montville. Date of assessment is year that you came to Montville.

Be sure to include your current mailing address on line #8.

The affidavit needs to be signed either by a CO, ExO, Legal Officer or Notary Public.

Please include a copy of a recent full-length LES (DFAS Form 702, Jan 02) showing the state box (or your DD-214, if discharged).

When you register out of state, cancel your Connecticut license plates directly with CT DMV at www.ct.gov/dmv to avoid future tax bills.
