There will be a watercourse and wetland crossings involved with this harvest. Timber bridge mats and/or corduroy will be used for the crossings. Water bars, seed, and/or hay will be used post-harvest in areas prone to erosion and soil disturbance. All Best Management Practices regarding timber harvesting as adopted by the CT DEEP will be strictly adhered to.
