Notice of General Permit Reissuance for the Discharge of Domestic and Remedial Wastewater General Permit No. CTDR000

The Department of Energy & Environmental Protection (DEEP) hereby gives notice of the reissuance of the General Permit for the Discharge of Domestic and Remedial Wastewater ("DQR GP") on February 27, 2026, becoming effective March 1, 2026, and expiring on February 28, 2031.
