As per ordinance regulating excavations, cuts, fill and change in grade in public highways adopted at Town Council meeting on May 13,1991 Town of Montville, record & minutes Vol 8, page 19.

Permission is hereby granted to regrade and construct a street entrance within the highway area abutting property of (property owner):

At the location designated heron, under the supervision of the Montville Highway department, subject to the statements made on the application for permit and subject further to the following.

1. Driveway is to be constructed of bituminous concrete, two (2) inches in depth, properly compacted and placed over not less than six (6) inches of suitable gravel. The driveway shall have a minimum width of twelve (12) feet and minimum length of fifteen (15) feet measure from the gutter line of the highway and shall a-but the traveled portion of the highway. The driveway, at the intersection of the gutter line shall have a radius of twenty-five (25) feet on each side.
2. The driveway entrance must be stabilized for a sufficient distance to control erosion and be constructed in a manner that will confine highway water to the gutter area and permit free flow.
3. Normal traffic shall be maintained at all times.
4. Suitable egress and ingress shall be maintained for all property owners who may have a right of way over the driveway.
5. Where blasting is required, the Public Works Director and Fire Marshall shall be notified in advance.
6. Work under this permit shall be done so as not to damage the facilities of others or damage the drainage systems of the town.
7. No trees or shrubbery abutting another property owner shall be removed until such property owner is notified and permission is granted by the Tree Warden.
8. The owner shall be responsible for all traffic control costs.
9. A \$2000 passbook bond will be required from November 1st - April 1st.
10. A C.O will not be issued unless driveway apron is complete or a passbook bond is posted.
