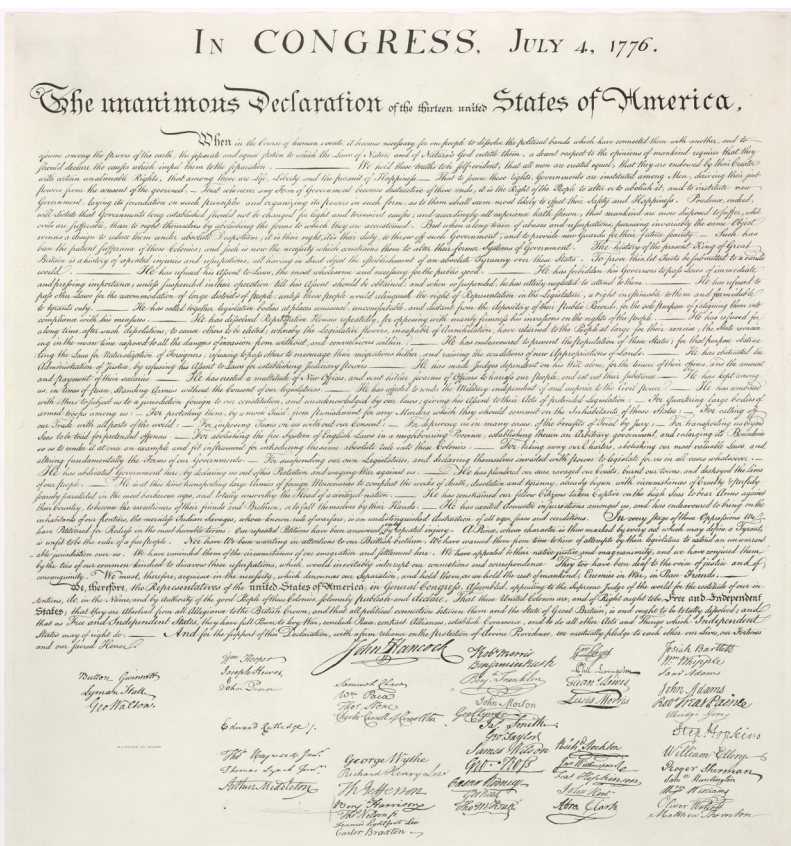

Groups are broken down into boys and girls and then age groups of 5-6, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12. Each group will have their own counselors who plan the activities each week.
