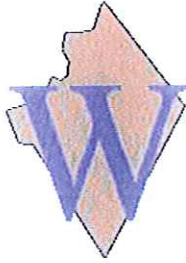

VII.B Wetland Activity Description

Existing Conditions

The site consists of approximately 18 acres with a farmhouse and outbuildings located on the southern side of Maple Avenue just westerly of Interstate 395. The site is mostly wooded and slopes gently to moderately northward towards Maple Avenue. A small wetlands system parallels Maple Avenue that drains to the east through a culvert located in the I-395 right of way and northerly under Maple Ave.

Proposed Wetlands Permit Activities:

This application is part of a 2 lot subdivision that would split the existing single family home onto its own 2.7 acre lot (Lot 1). The remaining land will be 15.18 acres in size (Lot 2).

Lot 1 (existing house lot) has no new activity proposed within wetlands or 50' uplands review area.

Lot 2 requires a wetlands crossing for driveway access, underground utilities and a proposed culvert pipe for conveyance of a seasonal intermittent watercourse. The activities proposed as part of this driveway crossing include:

- 4,900 sf of direct wetlands disturbance as part of driveway, drainage and grading activities
- Total fill in wetlands = 250 cy of clean fill and gravel materials
- Total excavation in wetlands = 250 cy of organics / topsoil removed. Organic materials will be stockpiled onsite outside of 50' upland review area for reuse as topsoil
- 7,200 sf of upland review area disturbance

- All work to be performed by tracked excavation equipment with minimal hand tool activity.
- Proposed work is intended to be performed starting in the spring of 2027 and should be completed within 90 – 180 days.
- Width of proposed driveway crossing over wetlands is designed to allow access to potential future multifamily development of parcel without requiring additional wetlands disturbance.

Potential Impacts to Wetlands and Watercourse

The majority of required site clearing has occurred as part of a timber harvest for the site. Erosion and sediment controls are in place and being maintained.

Wetlands and intermittent watercourse direct impacts -No direct impacts are proposed as part of the proposed development.

Impacts to uplands review areas -

Intermittent Watercourse & wetlands-Minimal incursions into the wetlands and 50 foot upland review area for site access, underground utilities, grading and drainage facilities. Other than the site entrance drive and associated infrastructure, no other activities are located within the wetlands or upland review areas.

All proposed activities have been designed to minimize short and long term impacts to wetlands and watercourses. Site specific erosion control plan is included in the application materials.

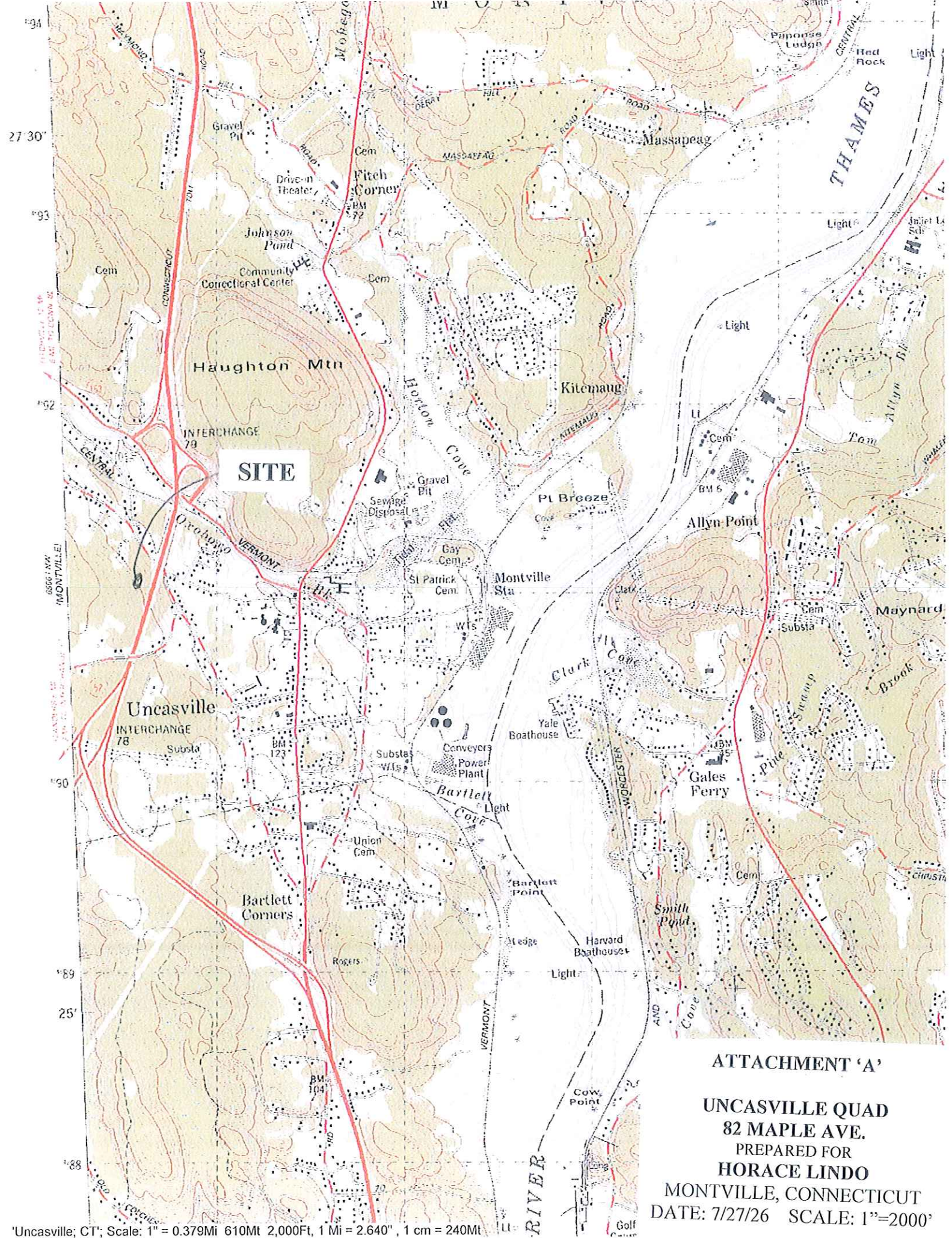
