MINUTES

A Town Meeting of the electors and qualified taxpayers of the Town of Montville was held at Montville Town Hall Council Chambers, 310 Norwich New London Tpke. Uncasville, CT 06382 on Wednesday, July 29, 2026 from 4:00 – 7:00 P.M.

The Chairman of the Town Council Timothy May called the meeting to order at 4:00 PM and presided as Moderator. Town Clerk, Katie Haring, was present to record the minutes. Representing the Registrar of Voters Office was Jeffrey Rogers, Mary Hillman, Meracus Hernandez and Michelle Deshong-Cure to check the names of those wishing to vote at the Town Meeting as well as Kristy Kupec, Assessor. The pledge of allegiance followed.

Moderator Tim May informed voters that they may cast their vote at any time during the meeting once the ballot box has been opened and drop their ballot in the ballot box.

Town Clerk Katie Haring read the following legal notice, return of posting and publication of the meeting and voter information.

WHO MAY VOTE IN A SPECIAL TOWN MEETING:

In accordance with Section 7-6 of the Connecticut General Statutes of the State of Connecticut, as amended, only an elector of the Town or citizen of the United States of the age eighteen years or more who, jointly or severally, was liable to the Town for taxes assessed against him based on an assessment of not less than \$1,000 on the last completed grand list of the Town, or who would be so liable if not entitled to an exemption as a blind person or as a veteran or as a parent or surviving spouse of a veteran would be entitled to vote at the meeting.

Moderator Tim May went on to appoint Registrar of Voters Jeffrey Rogers & Mary Hillman as well as Deputy Registrar of Voters Michelle Deshong-Cure & Meracus Hernandez to act as checkers for the town meeting.

Moderator Tim May then made the motion that the Town Meeting approve the discontinuance of PTA Lane, Uncasville, CT as described in Town Council Resolution No. 2026-59, adopted by the Town Council at its special meeting on July 20, 2026. Motion was seconded by Katie Haring.

The Moderator called the meeting to recess at 4:05 P.M. and voting ensued.

The Moderator called the meeting back to order at 7:05 P.M. and results were tallied.

The Moderator reported the results of the question as follows:

“SHALL THE TOWN MEETING APPROVE THE DISCONTINUANCE OF PTA LANE, UNCASVILLE, CT AS DESCRIBED IN TOWN COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 2026-59, ADOPTED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL AT ITS SPECIAL MEETING ON JULY 20, 2026?”
