D. Rowley commented that he interviewed Josh Cushing and Trevor Sindorf on Cable Access Channel 22 and that it is currently airing. Also, he visited district schools during American Education week and observed student and faculty use of SMART Boards.

Item 10. Superintendent's Report. a. Report from the Director of Student Services – Ms. Maynard.

D. Maynard reported the following:

- D. Maynard discussed the preschool program. With the elimination of one section, there is growing concern that the numbers in each class will increase beyond capacity. She monitors the class size and keeps in contact with the preschool staff monthly. She also has spoken to P. Aubin regarding class size and ensuring that it is appropriately staffed. The October 1 Child Count for this year had 17 fewer students than last year at the same time. Should the need arise, the plan would be to move the permanent substitute into a preschool position. There is room for at least 12 additional preschool students.
- We have been working on getting the SEDAC data accurate so that we will be able to submit it by its due date of December 5th. PSIS will open on Tuesday, November 27. At that time, corrections can be made and we should be able to do our final data cleansing.

b. Report from Assistant Superintendent – Mr. Levesque.

B. Levesque reported the following:

- B. Levesque has begun the E-rate process for the 2013-2014 fiscal year. The process begins with the completion of the Form 470. He started some preliminary work on it this week and will finish it next week. E-Rate funding provides the district with a 50% discount on telephone and internet services.
- The fiber installation will be completed on December 4. All schools will experience a slight interruption in their internet services on this day.
- W. Sherwin, J. Theodoss and B. Levesque met with two members of the Montville Lacrosse Boosters Club today. The group has applied for their non-profit status and has met other requirements to get started. With their funding support, we will have both a girls and boys club Lacrosse team this spring.

c. Monthly Update.

P. Aubin reported the following:

• The work on the review of the teacher evaluation pilot and the current plan is ongoing. As we receive training, we continue to have more questions about the state model and the associated documents, rubrics and forms.

- Principals and department managers/supervisors will be submitting their proposed budgets on November 30th. B. Levesque, K. Lamoureux and P. Aubin will be reviewing requests as she prepares the Superintendent's Budget.
- On Thursday, November 15, P. Aubin attended the State Teacher of the Year program with the Montville 2013 Teacher of the Year at the Bushnell in Hartford.
- The plans for the CABE Legislative breakfast for Superintendents, BOE Chairs/representatives and leadership for CABE and CAPSS are well underway. Invitations have been issued and the date has been set for Thursday, December 6, 2012 at 7:45-9:00 AM.
