Resolution #2014-37. THE TOWN OF MONTVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES to form an ad-hoc committee known as the Montville Law Enforcement Feasibility Committee. It shall be the responsibility of the Committee to investigate, document and report its finding to the Montville Town Council any and all advantages and/or disadvantages to the Town of Montville transitioning from the current Constabulary under the Connecticut State Police - Resident Trooper Program to a statutorily recognized organized Police Department with a Chief of Police. This Committee will consist of seven (7) members and the make-up will be as follows: one (1) member from the Town Council, one (1) member from the Public Safety Commission, and five (5) members at large. This Committee will report its findings in writing to the Town Council in six (6) month after their first meeting. Identifiable Topics to Report are current language of the Montville Town Charter Section 408. Public Safety Commission and all applicable town ordinances; Administration as it applies to agency organizational structure (i.e. reports and records); Organizational developments (i.e. staffing, support staff); Cost assessments (i.e. adding necessary divisions); Dispatch and Communication needs (i.e. duties and responsibilities, staffing); comparable towns; department policy and procedure changes and overseeing authority.
