Phil Orbe reported:

- 62.7% of students are athletes, 385 out of 614 students. That represents the highest number of athletes we have ever had. For the first time in the history of Montville High School, we have more female than male athletes. This reflects the district's focus on equal distribution of funds for male and female teams.

- Football is down from 67 to 38 participants from last year. This might be a sign of heightened awareness of concussion injuries.

- Multi-sport athletes (3) - 49 athletes on three sports, up from 12 to 49 in last several years. Benefit to staying active across multiple seasons.
