- A. Grants (State & Local)
  - Submitted application for SOR (State Opioid Response) Grant for \$5,000.00 (billboards, education, PSAs)
  - Submitting MEF Grant for "App" Development program called "Mad Learn" which provides curriculum & training for youth to create their own phone "App" based on personal interests (ie: animals, resources, poetry, etc.) Great for Summer Center kids if approved. Part of STEM learning.
  - Exploring for drug free communities grant

  - MYSB budget submitted for review to Mayor to present to Town Council, state budgets look ok so far. Money taken out and then put back (thankfully!).
