REOPENING: DID YOU KNOW THIS?

- 1. The max attendees is 150 for an outdoor graveside funeral.
- 2. Restaurants can build dividers between tables with Plexiglas or wood that are 30" above the table.
- 3. Salons, gyms and other places cannot build dividers.
- 4. Buffets, passed appetizers and other "in the open food" are not allowed.
- 5. Most everything requires an appointment or ordering ahead online or on the phone.
- 6. Masks should be worn when 6' distancing cannot be guaranteed.
- 7. Masks should not be worn during heavy physical exercise or exertion.
- 8. Masks should not be worn if you are driving a car alone or are outside alone.
- 9. People at risk (over 65 and/or those with serious medical illnesses) should still stay at home and not go out unless essential.
- 10. As an employer, you cannot tell your employee that may be in a high-risk category to stay home. It is their choice, not yours.
- 11. As an employer, you can send home any employee that exhibits symptoms, or anyone refusing to be tested for COVID, or anyone who did not self-test, without repercussions.
- 12. If you are a non-essential business, you can refuse service to anyone not wearing a mask, even if they have a medical condition.
