Sold, Gifted, and/or Auctioned Equipment

The Chairman and Committee will be notified regarding any equipment that is to be sold, gifted, or auctioned off by the town.

Old Raymond Hill Church

The electrical meters at the old Raymond Hill Church have been installed and they are in the process of purchasing exhaust fans to circulate the air in the building and help alleviate the mold issue.

Boat Launch Area

Chairman Caron commended the Public Works Department on the boat launch area, where trees and brush have been cut and cleared and millings have been placed. The area is being cleaned weekly. Riprap, along with fabric, will be placed on the hill.

Road Clean-up and Weed Whacking

Three (3) part-time and one (1) full-time employee have been hired to weed whack and clean the trash along the side of the town roads. Public Works Director Bourdeau will contact the state to request that the vegetation be cut to improve the site lines and trash be picked up along Routes 163 and 32. Chairman Caron stated that, he, too, has contacted the Senator for the same.

Other Roads

- Available options for the Holly Hill Drive road repair project are being investigated.
- Signage will be placed on Maple Avenue cautioning drivers that children are playing in the area.
- Massapeag Road will be investigated and reviewed for possible clean up.

Transfer Station Stickers

An item regarding the possibility of prorating the transfer station stickers for a period of at least six (6) months will be added to next month's agenda for discussion.

They are currently working on remedying an issue with the scanners' inability to read the barcodes through the windshield.
