Anthony C. Tufares, 2016 Ford Platinum F-150, List No. 65280 Teresa L. & Anthony C. Tufares, 2019 Honda Pilot EL, List No. 65281

Mr. Tufares was sworn in by Chairperson Turner. Mr. Tufares stated that the Ford F-150 truck is utilized as a work vehicle and has approximately 110,000 miles. As a work vehicle, it has sustained related damage. The Honda currently has approximately 48,000 miles and

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has been involved in two accidents. The damage sustained from the most recent accident was recently repaired by B&D Autobody; a copy of the receipt was provided to the Board. The Board Members exited Town Council Chambers with Mr. Tufares to view both of the vehicles at 9:04 a.m. and returned at 9:08 a.m.

### John F. Biedermeier, 2002 Altec Sawrig Woodchipper, List No. 51206

Mr. Biedermeier was sworn in by Chairperson Turner. Mr. Biedermeier stated that the value of the woodchipper was lower in 2019 compared to 2020. Based on the manner in which woodchippers are built, he stated the difficulty with determining the year of such equipment.
